

**BOUNDARY AND STUDENT ASSIGNMENT RECOMMENDATIONS  
PRESENTED TO DAVENPORT COMMUNITY SCHOOLS BOARD  
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING – FEBRUARY 6, 2006**

**The following boundary and student assignment changes will be effective beginning with the 2006-2007 school year. Grandfathering of current students will apply in all recommendations.**

- A. **It is expected that students at the elementary level will attend their home school;** however, students will have the opportunity of transferring to a school outside their home attendance area to attend a charter school or a school targeted under the district's desegregation plan, or if their request to attend a school outside their home attendance area complies with the District's current policy regarding such transfers.
- B. **It is expected that students at the intermediate level will attend their home school;** however, students will have the opportunity of transferring to a school outside their home attendance area to a school targeted under the district's desegregation plan, or if their request to attend a school outside of their home attendance area complies with the District's current policy regarding such transfers.
- C. **Home school attendance at the high school level is strongly encouraged;** however, students will have the choice of transferring to a school outside their home attendance area as long as there is space and they provide their own transportation.
- D. **The following elementary school attendance areas/boundaries changes are recommended:**
1. Buffalo to Hayes:
    - Extend Hayes boundary to include students west of Fairmount, south of Hobson, south of Rockingham, and north of River Drive.
  2. Fillmore to Truman:
    - Add the north side of West 58<sup>th</sup> Street between Division and Pine to Truman attendance area.
  3. Eisenhower to Lincoln creating a home school boundary for Lincoln:
    - South of East 12<sup>th</sup>, west of Farnam Street, north of Mississippi River, East of Brady.
  4. Wilson to Jefferson:
    - Extend existing Jefferson attendance area to include south of West 6<sup>th</sup>, west of Brady, north of Mississippi river, east of Scott Street.
  5. Garfield to Madison:
    - Extend existing Madison attendance area to include south of west 12<sup>th</sup>, east of Brady, north of west 6<sup>th</sup>, east of Scott Street.
- E. **'Principal agreements' will be eliminated beginning with the 2006-2007 school year. (Current agreements will continue to be honored.)**

**NOTE:** The District remains committed to the continued implementation of the district's voluntary desegregation policy. Enrollment will be evaluated annually to determine the status of each school according to desegregation plan guidelines. Only schools that qualify under the desegregation plan will be considered targeted schools.
