How Does the Program Work?

Family Resources' Pediatric Integrated Health Services offers free help to parents in meeting the physical health, mental health and social support needs of their children. Finding and accessing resources for children with emotional and/or behavioral needs can be confusing. Our Pediatric Integrated Health team is here to help!

Who Will I Work With?

A **Family Peer Support Specialist** is a parent who has experienced caring for a child with mental, emotional or behavioral challenges. This Specialist will provide you with direct support and help connect you with services for your child.

A **Care Coordinator** is a resource specialist and will help you and your child develop a plan and identify resources to help you achieve your goals.

A **Nurse** is available to help you manage your child's total medical and emotional health care needs.

What Can I Expect?

Your Integrated Health Team will:

- help you find answers to your questions or direct you to learning opportunities;
- facilitate communication and collaboration between your child, your family and your mental and physical health care providers;
- provide advocacy and 24/7 support;
- help you reach your physical and mental health care goals by providing **support, education, and access to resources;**
- provide support to help you cope, understand and learn new ways to manage your child's health care and emotional care needs through peer support; and
- assist you in finding supports and services for your child's behaviors.
