Who is eligible to apply?

- North High School Senior Athlete for the 2017 – 2018 year
- Must have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.50 or higher
- Must be planning to attend college or a trade school and be able to provide proof of enrollment and payment in the fall 2018 semester.
