Skills: All students are encouraged to participate regardless of their skill level to include non-swimmers.

Physicals: All 7th and 8th grade boys and girls must have a school physical prior to participating. Six graders do not need a physical.

Equipment: All swimmers are required to furnish their own swimsuit, towel, and goggles.

Eligibility: Students must meet the DCS academic standards of their school and have a signed parent permission slip located at the bottom of page.
