### **IMMUNIZATION UPDATE:**

Iowa law requires ALL students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade to show proof of having both the Meningococcal and the Tdap vaccines before school starts in August, unless the student has a Certificate of Immunization Exemption. There will be no grace/extension period, and students not meeting this requirement may NOT begin the school year until this has been met. Letters have been mailed home this week to all current 6<sup>th</sup> graders/incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders with information on these requirements. Now is a great time to contact your health care provider to make an appointment for your student to receive their updated immunizations before next school year. Please contact the school nurse with any questions. Thank you!
