As shared in the *School Leader Update* from the Iowa Department of Education:

Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) requires states to report the percent of parents with a child receiving special education services who report that schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving services and results for children with disabilities. This year, the Iowa Department of Education is gathering these data as

a census for both students with and without a disability using a three-question survey.

The Iowa Department of Education has requested the assistance of the AEA's to disseminate the survey link and instructions to building principals, nonpublic administrators, and preschool program contacts.

Please provide all parents (of students with and without IEPs) with the information contained in the IDEA Parent Survey – Letter to Parents document. This survey should be completed once for each child in the family. This can be done up to five times (a maximum of five children).
