9:15 Rehearsal begins with Bands lined up on sideline ready to take the field.

9:15 –9:45 Practice Entrance Onto the Field (twice)

9:45 –10:00 Massed Band Rehearse Each Piece (two times through)

10:00 –10:15 Move to Grand Old Flag positions and rehearse Grand Old Flag

10:15 –10:45 Full Run Through

10:45 –11:00 Take Seats in Stands
