Davenport Schools 6th, 7th & 8th Grade Swim Teams

Who: All 6th, 7th & 8th grade boys and girls who live in the Dav. School District.

Where: The NEW Davenport Central High School Pool.

When: Each school day starting Feb 6th thru Mar 17th from 3:15 to 4:30 on Wednesdays and 4:15 to 5:30 PM the other week nights. Times will be adjusted for swim meets.

Skills: All students are encouraged to participate regardless of their skill level to include non-swimmers.

Physicals: All 7th and 8th grade boys and girls must have a school physical prior to participating. Six graders do not need a physical.

Equipment: All swimmers are required to furnish their own swimsuit, towel, and goggles.

Eligibility: Students must meet the DCS academic standards of their school and have a signed parent permission slip located at the bottom of page.

Signup: All students are encouraged to signup in advance (signup sheets are in the schools main office. Students may also signup at parent meeting night.

Davenport Schools 6th, 7th & 8th Grade Girl's Diving Team

Who: All 6th, 7th & 8th grade girls who live in the Davenport School District. Students do NOT need to be attending a Davenport Intermediate School to participate.

Where: The NEW Davenport Central High School Pool.

When: Each school day Feb 6th thru Mar 17th from 5:45 to 7:15 (Except Wed). Wednesday practices will be from 4:45 to 6:15. Times will be adjusted for diving meets.

Skills: All students are encouraged to participate regardless of their skill level to include girls who have never dove before. All divers must pass a basic swim test before diving off the board. Swimming instructions will be provided for non-swimmers.

Physicals: All 7th and 8th grade girls must have a school physical prior to participating. Six graders do not need a physical.

Equipment: All divers are required to furnish their own swimsuit, and towel.

Eligibility: Students must meet the DCS academic standards of their school and have a signed parent permission slip located at the bottom of page.
