## **Solar Energy**

**The Davenport School District has plans to add solar panels to every building in the district, eventually working to become the first district in the state of Iowa to be powered completely by solar energy. The plans for each building have been presented to the school board and 2 informational forum sessions for the general public have been planned: Wednesday, January 4, 2017 – 6:00 pm – ASC Board Room Thursday, January 5, 2017 – 6:00 pm – West High School The official press release and additional info will most likely be in the media over the winter break. The initial phase of the work could lead to \$300,000-\$400,000 in savings per year; once the solar arrays are complete, the district looks to save upwards of \$2,000,000 per year.**
