*******IMPORTANT NOTE FROM DISTRICT OFFICE*******

Dear Davenport Community Schools families,

We wanted you to be aware of two incidents reported this week involving a male in a maroon van. Please read the following description:

Suspect Vehicle: Maroon Minivan with possibly Illinois license plates.
Suspect: A male white, Mid 50's, black and gray hair.
Tattoo right side of neck with a cross and flames.
Wearing a black stocking cap and dark blue Chicago Bears jacket.

A 5th grade student at Washington Elementary 1608 E. Locust St. reported two incidents involving a suspicious male in a maroon van. The first incident took place Tuesday 01/26/2010 at approximately 3:00pm. The student was walking home from school when she noticed the van following her sought on Mississippi from Locust St. The student saw the van again this morning between 7:00 and 7:30am. This time the student was walking north on Eastern Av. The student saw the van parked on the east side of Eastern Av, facing south. The student was walking northbound. As the student walked past the van, the driver got out asked ask the student to come talk to him. The student ignored the subject and walked up to Locust and Eastern Av. and reported the incident to the crossing guard.

A police report has been made about this incident. Extra patrols will be on site at both Washington and Sudlow before and after school. If you should see a van being driven by a subject matching the description given, try to obtain a license plate number and call 911 right away.
