How do I know if I have the flu? (CDC)

You may have the flu if you have some or all of these symptoms:



- fever *
 - cough
 - sore throat
 - runny or stuffy nose
 - body aches
 - headache
 - chills
 - fatigue
 - sometimes diarrhea and vomiting
- *Not everyone with flu will have a fever.

Students that present with 2 or more of these symptoms will be asked to wear a mask until they leave the building; and a letter from the School district “Taking Care of Students and Other Family Members with the Flu”.

Please keep your student home from school when he/she is ill. Students may return to school when they have been symptom free for 24 hours.

The Davenport School system is working closely with the Scott County Health Department.

 - Disinfecting equipment and workstations
 - Staying home when sick
