

SPECIAL CALL CLOSED SESSION
Minutes
January 28th, 2015
4:30PM

The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on January 28th, 2015 pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady St., Davenport, Iowa, in said District in the Executive Board Room. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 4:45PM. On roll call the following board members were present: Directors, Johanson, Snyder, Clewell, and Dickmann. Executive Director Rob Scott and Dr. Lesile O'Meila and Board Secretary, Mary Correthers also attended.

Motion: Director Clewell moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Snyder seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.

The Board moved into closed session at 4:46PM.

The Board moved into deliberation at 5:30PM

Motion: Director Snyder made a motion to adjourn the closed session and move into open session. Director Dickmann seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Motion carried. The Board returned to open session at 6:18PM.

President Johanson stated that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1123 the Board adopts the findings of fact set out by the Administrative Advisory Council, and the board concludes the student violated the regulation and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the student is detrimental to the best interest of the school.

Motion: Director Snyder moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1123.

- 1) That Student Case #1123 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District through the end of the 2014-15 school year with no services; and

- 2) That Student Case #1123 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team or group is participating during the time of the expulsion; and
- 3) That Student Case #1123 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District until after a psychological evaluation from a competent professional and recommendation by the Administrative Advisory Council.

Director Dickmann seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follow: Ayes: Snyder, Dickmann Clewell and Johanson.
Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT

Motion: Director Clewell moved the Board adjourn. Director Dickmann seconded the motion. President Johanson declared the meeting adjourned at 6:21PM.
