

SPECIAL CALL CLOSED SESSION
January 8, 2014
3:00PM

The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on January 8, 2014 pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady St., Davenport, Iowa, in said District in the Executive Board Room. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 3:00PM. On roll call the following board members were present: Directors, Johanson, Snyder, Clewell and DeFauw. Executive Administrator, Rob Scott and Mary Correthers, Board Secretary were also present.

Motion: Director Clewell moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Snyder seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.

The Board moved into closed session at 3:01 PM.

The Board moved into deliberation at 3:55PM

Motion: Director Clewell made a motion to adjourn the closed session and move into open session. Director Snyder seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous. Motion carried. The Board returned to open session at 4:25 PM.

President Johanson stated that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1118 the Board adopts the findings of facts set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the board concludes the student violated the regulation and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school.

Motion: Director DeFauw moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1118.

- 1) That Student Case #1118 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District through the end of the 2013-14 school year with services; and
- 2) That Student Case #1118 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team or group is participating during the time of the expulsion and;

- 3) That Student Case #1118 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District prior to evaluation by a substance abuse professional and recommendation by the Administrative Advisory Council.

Director Clewell seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follow: Ayes: DeFauw, Clewell, Snyder and Johanson. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT

Motion: Director Snyder moved the Board adjourn. Director DeFauw seconded the motion. By consensus the Board agreed to adjourn the meeting. President Johanson declared the meeting adjourned at 4:27 PM.
