The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on May 6th, 2015 pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady St., Davenport, Iowa, in said District at the Achievement Service Center, Executive Board Room. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 5:00PM. On roll call the following board members were present: Directors Dickmann, Snyder, Hayes, Clewell and Johanson.

Director Clewell moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Snyder seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried. The Board moved into closed session at 5:02PM.

Director Clewell moved to adjourn the closed session and move into open session. Seconded by Director Dickmann. All ayes motion carried. The board returned to open session at 6:50PM.

Moved by Clewell and seconded by Dickmann the board approved the following:

1. That Student #1126 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District through the end of first semester of the 2015-16 school year; and
2. That Student #1126 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District Property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport Team or group is participating during the time of the expulsion; and
3. That Student #1126 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District until after a psychological evaluation from a competent professional and recommendation by the Administrative Advisory Council; and
4. That Student #1126 is encouraged to maintain communication with counselor and may be provided syllabi and textbooks as appropriate; and
5. That Student #1126 is encouraged to continue anger management counseling.

Vote: Ayes: Clewell, Dickmann, Hayes and Johanson. Nays: Snyder. Motion carried. Director Clewell moved the Board adjourn. Director Dickmann seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:56 PM.
