The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on April 22, 2015, pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady Street, Davenport, Iowa, in said District in the Executive Board Room.

President Johanson called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. On roll call the following board members were present: Directors Johanson, Hayes, Dickmann, DeFauw and Snyder. Superintendent Art Tate and Superintendent's Assistant Brenda Thie also attended.

Motion: Director Dickmann moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)E of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel, or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or the guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Snyder seconded the motion. All ayes, motion carried.

The Board moved into closed session at approximately 4:10 p.m. The Board moved into deliberation at approximately 5:30 p.m.

By consensus, the Board returned to open session at 5:35 p.m.

President Johanson stated that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1124, the Board adopts the Findings of Fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school.

Motion: Director Dickmann moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1124:

That Student Case #1124 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School
District through the end of the first semester of the 2015-16 school year without
services; and

- 2. That Student Case #1124 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team or group is participating during the time of the expulsion; and
- 3. That Student Case #1124 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District until after a psychological evaluation from a competent professional and recommendation by the Administrative Council.
- 4. That Student Case #1124 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District without a written and signed letter of promise to not use physical assault to solve problems and to go to an authority figure when problems arise.

Director Hayes seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes: Snyder, Dickmann, DeFauw, Hayes, Johanson. Motion carried.
