AWARDS AND ACCOLADES

The Children's Village program has received recognition as a FINE award winner (First in the Nation in Education) and is a state leader in providing innovative and quality learning programs for young children. The initial Children's Village, which opened in 1998 in a former elementary school, was one of the first early childhood learning centers in Iowa to develop and implement benchmarks and standards for pre-K students. The program currently houses children 3 to 5 years of age and attributes its success in preparing children to enter kindergarten to research-based practices such as quality staff, a suitable environment, appropriate grouping practices, consistent schedules, and parent involvement.

All sites are accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). Children's Village West received this honor in 2008, followed by Hoover in 2012. NAEYC is a professional organization which promotes excellence in early childhood education through a set of national standards. To receive or renew accreditation, an organization must not only demonstrate that it meets NAEYC standards, but will also have a site visit from NAEYC Assessors. Following accreditation, the organization must submit an annual report and agree to additional verification and random unannounced visits to demonstrate they are maintaining those standards. We're proud of the teaching staff and the families of our Children's Villages for continuing to uphold the mark of quality represented by the NAEYC Accreditation system!
