SPECIAL CALL CLOSED SESSION  
EXECUTIVE BOARD ROOM  
October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015

The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015 pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady St., Davenport, Iowa, in said District at the Achievement Service Center, Executive Board Room. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 4:00PM. On roll call the following board members were present: Directors Dickmann, Snyder, Gosa, Clewell, Snyder, Hayes and Johanson.

Director Dickmann moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Hayes seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried. The Board moved into closed session at 4:01PM. Director Dickmann moved to adjourn the closed session and move into open session. Motion seconded by Director DeSalvo. All Ayes motion carried. The board returned to open session at 6:18PM.

After the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1128 the Board concluded the student did violate the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school and that Student #1128 brought a knife to school and that Student #1128 threatened another student and that student #1128 aggressively followed after another student with a knife and that Student #1128 has a history of and admitted to engaging in previous disruptive behavior. Motion by Director Clewell and seconded by Snyder the board approved the following:

1. That Student Case #1128 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District until the beginning of the third quarter of the 2015-16 school year without services; and
2. That Student Case #1128 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team or group is participating during the time of the expulsion.
3. That Student Case #1128 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District until after receiving a psychological evaluation for a competent professional and recommendation by a District hearing officer. The board expects the hearing officer to carefully evaluate the student's prior behavioral referrals provided to the board at the time of the expulsion hearing prior to the recommendation for readmission.

Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:25PM.
