SPECIAL CALL CLOSED SESSION

The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on May 2<sup>th</sup>, 2016 pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady St., Davenport, Iowa, in said District at the Achievement Service Center, Executive Board Room. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 3:30PM.

On roll call the following board members were present:

Directors Johanson, Snyder, Gosa and Mayfield. Director Gosa moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Snyder seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried. The Board moved into closed session at 3:31PM.

Director Snyder moved to adjourn the closed session and move into open session. Motion seconded by Director Mayfield. All Ayes motion carried. The board returned to open session at 5:05PM. After the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #11443 the Board concluded the student did violate the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school. Motion by Snyder and seconded by Gosa the board approved the following: All ayes motion carried.

1. That Student #1143 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District until the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of the 2016-17 school year with services. These services will be provided as long as the administration feels that the services are being utilized; and
2. That Student #1143 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team or group is participating during the time of the expulsion; and
3. That Student #1143 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District until after a psychological evaluation from a competent professional and recommendation by and a meeting with a Hearing Officer to determine placement.

Director Snyder moved the meeting adjourn and seconded by Director Gosa. The meeting adjourned at 5:10PM.
