SPECIAL CALL CLOSED SESSION
September 20th, 2016**

The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on September 20th, 2016 pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady St., Davenport, Iowa, in said District at the Achievement Service Center, Executive Board Room. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 4:40PM.

On roll call the following board members were present: Directors Johanson, Snyder, DeSalvo, Hayes and Mayfield. Director Snyder moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Hayes seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried. The Board moved into closed session at 4:41PM.

Director Hayes moved to adjourn the closed session and move into open session. Motion seconded by Director DeSalvo. All Ayes motion carried. The board returned to open session at 5:23 PM.

After the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1147 the Board concluded the student did violate the regulations and rules established by the Board. The Board found the following Finding of Fact: The student posted a threatening and inappropriate message on Snapchat and admitted to doing so.

Motion by Snyder and seconded by Hayes the board approved the following:

1. That Student #1147 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District until the last day of the first semester of the 2016-17 school year with services; and
2. That Student #1147 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team or group is participating during the time of the expulsion; and
3. That Student #1147 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District until after a recommendation by the District Hearing Officer. All Ayes motion carried.

Director Hayes moved the meeting adjourn and seconded by Director Snyder. The meeting adjourned at 5:25PM.
