SPECIAL CALL CLOSED SESSION
September 21th, 2016**

The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on September 21th, 2016 pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady St., Davenport, Iowa, in said District at the Achievement Service Center, Executive Board Room. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 4:30PM.

On roll call the following board members were present: Directors Johanson, Snyder, Hayes and Clewell. Director Hayes moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Snyder seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried. The Board moved into closed session at 4:31PM.

Director Snyder moved to adjourn the closed session and move into open session. Motion seconded by Director Hayes. All Ayes motion carried. The board returned to open session at 6:00PM.

After the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #1149 the Board concluded the student did violate the regulations and rules established by the Board. The Board found the following Finding of Fact: The student was involved in an altercation and failed to follow the directions of staff.

Motion by Clewell and seconded by Hayes the board approved the following:

1. That Student #1149 will be suspended from the Davenport School District through September 23rd;
2. That Student #1149 will undergo Diversion the week of September 26-30. Diversion in this case is containing the student separate from other students while she receives the appropriate classroom instruction so the student does not fall behind;
3. That Student #1149 will be returned to regular classroom instruction on October 3, 2016.
All Ayes motion carried.

Director Hayes moved the meeting adjourn and seconded by Director Snyder. The meeting adjourned at 6:02PM.
