The Board of Directors of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met in a Special Call Closed Session on January 11, 2016 pursuant to law and the rules of said Board. The meeting was held at 1606 Brady St., Davenport, Iowa, in said District at the Achievement Service Center, Executive Board Room. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 4:30PM. . On roll call the following board members were present: Directors Clewell, Snyder, Gosa, Hayes, DeSalvo and Johanson.

Director Hayes moved the Board go into closed session as provided in Section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director DeSalvo seconded the motion. All ayes motion carried. The Board moved into closed session at 4:31PM.

Director Hayes moved to adjourn the closed session and move into open session. Seconded by Director Snyder. All ayes motion carried. The board returned to open session at 5:35PM.

Moved by Clewell and seconded by Hayes the board approved the following:

1. That Student #33 knowingly violated school policy and acted contrary to the orderly and efficient operation of the school.
2. That Student #33 will be excluded from the Davenport Community School District through the end of first semester of the 2015-16 school year with services; and
3. That Student #33 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District Property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport Team or group is participating during the time of the exclusion; and
4. That Student #33 will not be readmitted to the Davenport Community School District until after a psychological evaluation from a competent professional and recommendation by a District Hearing Officer and a Special Education Administrator.
