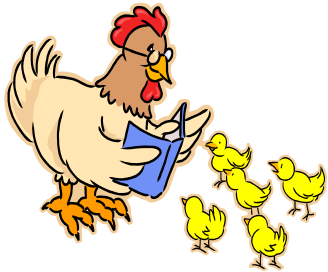
Ice Skating at the River's Edge

The concert is free of charge and is about 45 minutes long. Children attending should be of the age to be able to listen to and enjoy an orchestra.

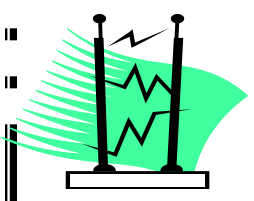
Please sign up by February 17th as seating is limited to 30. The Adler Theater is located at 136 East 3rd Street in Davenport.
