AUDIT REPORT RELEASED FOR THE

YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2015

Davenport, Iowa-Eide Bailly LLP released an audit report on February 23, 2016 on the Davenport Community School District for the year ended June 30, 2015.

Revenues for the school district for the year ended June 30, 2015, totaled \$214,758,791, a 3.4 percent increase from the prior year. Revenues included \$80,066,135 in property and other district taxes; \$80,262,330 in unrestricted state aid and grants; \$47,126,388 from operating and capital grants and contributions; and \$5,633,946 from charges for services.

Expenses for the year totaled \$200,941,405, a 3.6 percent increase from the prior year. Expenses included \$132,454,398 for instruction; \$12,718,459 for plant operation and maintenance; \$9,719,379 for building administration; \$7,013,751 for student support services; \$6,817,320 for area education agency; \$6,427,016 for student transportation; \$6,179,430 for business and central administration; and \$8,530,490 for the business-type activities.
