ANNOUNCES ADJUSTMENT TO THE
SCHOOL CALENDAR**

Davenport, Iowa-The Davenport Community School District has announced that the last day of school for students for the 2015-2016 academic year will be Wednesday, May 25, 2016 with a two-hour early dismissal.

The District is taking advantage of the fact that extra time was purposefully built into the calendar to ensure we met the minimum threshold of 1080 hours of instructional time for each school year. For the second year in a row the district does not have to make up any snow/inclement weather days at the end of this school year. This has allowed us to adjust our academic calendar to make the last day for students Wednesday, May 25, 2016.

Teachers will use Thursday, May 26 and Friday, May 27 as professional development days.
