

Superintendent's Recommendations Concerning The Long-Range Facility Plan

August 3, 2015

1. The Board should consider, discuss, and eventually adopt the 10-year plan for facility refurbishing and maintenance using Secure and Advanced Vision for Education (SAVE) and Physical Plant and Equipment Level (PPEL) funds. Adoption to be completed August 24, 2015, realizing that the board will approve projects as they come forward, and can revisit the 10-year plan at any time.
2. The Board approve on August 24, 2015, a resolution to consider the closure of JB Young K-8 School at the end of the 2015-2016 school year.
3. The Achievement Service Center (ASC) be moved to the vacant JB Young building during school year 2016-2017, and the current ASC structure be sold.
4. Parts of the first floor of the current JB Young building to become a community center with support and services designed specifically to complement neighborhood needs.
5. Further study be done to determine whether another school should be closed in school year 2017-2018; and/or whether leadership consolidation should be considered.
6. Facility discussions continue and include future disposition of the Davenport Learning Center (Keystone Academy) and other properties such as the National Guard facility.
