**COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE**

The Board of the Davenport Community School District in the Counties of Scott and Muscatine, State of Iowa, met on Monday, December 3, 2018 for a Committee of the Whole Meeting. The meeting was held at the Achievement Service Center, 1702 Main Street, Davenport, Iowa, in said District. President Johanson called the meeting to order at 5:30PM. Present: Director's Johanson, Hayes, DeSalvo, Beck, and Potts. Gosa participated by phone. Mayfield was absent.

**1. Career and Technical Education Update**

Corri Guy, Director of Curriculum introduced Jennifer Boyd, Curriculum Specialist and Lauren Hargrave, Carl Perkins Facilitator. They provided an update to the board on the district's CTE (Career and Technical Education) programs. They highlighted and discussed programs and events that focused on career experiences such as apprenticeships, job shadows, guest speakers and industry tours. There are currently 13 career pathway programs for students in the areas of business, health services, family and consumer science and technical education. Guest speakers have included industry experts from Wells Fargo, John Deere and Masonry Institute of Iowa. A total of 764 students have been impacted by a career experience this school year. They announced a very exciting event called "Career Night Expo" scheduled for January 17th from 5-8:30PM. The keynote speaker at this event will be Mark Parma, best-selling author and national education expert. Board members complimented staff on the great job they are doing by offering great programs in the district. DeSalvo emphasized how these programs and events really make Davenport special and how these programs should really be a focus of the marking department to spread the word about the success of these programs.

**2. Board Real Estate Committee**

The possibility of forming a board real estate committee was discussed. Gosa explained this would be a committee of several board members and district staff involved in real estate matters and would provide the opportunity for the board to be updated more regularly on topics related to real estate. He said it seems items for approval come up so quickly and having this type of committee would provide an opportunity for board members to discuss ahead of time and be more informed prior to a vote on these types of action items. DeSalvo said she thought it was a good idea. Johanson asked board members to contact the board secretary if they were interested in serving on this committee and if there are more than 3 board members interested he will make a decision.
