

**Davenport Community School District  
Free Meal Program FAQs  
September 16, 2020**

**1) Who will receive free meals and when does it start?**

ALL CURRENTLY ENROLLED DCSD STUDENTS can receive free meals regardless of income level or school. Free meals will be available to those in the Hybrid Model as well as 100% Online Only students. Free meals begin District-wide on Monday, September 21, 2020.

**2) What does it include?**

The free meals program includes breakfast AND lunch daily.

100% Online Only students who have pre-registered for meals will pick up meals every Tuesday between 10AM and 1PM at the Davenport Learning Center. The DLC is located at 1008 W. Kimberly Road in Davenport, near the Department of Motor Vehicles and behind KFC. At pick-up, students will receive meals for the week.

For Hybrid Model students, meals will be provided on days in-school, and take-home meals will be provided on the student's last day in-person for the week. Students must pre-register for take-home meals.

Once you order meals, they will continue until you cancel. To cancel, call Operations at 563-336-7430.

100% Online Only students who have pre-registered for meals will pick up meals every Tuesday between 11AM and 1PM at the Davenport Learning Center. The DLC is located at 1008 W. Kimberly Road in Davenport, near the Department of Motor Vehicles and behind KFC. Students will be provided meals for the week.

Hybrid Model students who wish to have take-home meals and are not already receiving them can [contact their building](#) and ask to have meals sent home.

**4) What is the breakfast menu and lunch menu?**

Visit [Davenport Schools Meal Viewer](#) to see what's for breakfast or lunch at any school on any day of the school year. Take-home meals may vary from what is posted on the menu.

**5) Are extra entree items and snacks included with the free meals?**

NO. The free meal program only includes an entree, fruit, vegetables, and milk.

Below is pricing for additional meals:

Snacks and drinks at the high schools and junior highs are NOT included but will still be offered and will be charged to the student's lunch account.

**6) If my student brings his/her lunch from home, is a milk carton free?**

No. The free program is ONLY for a complete meal. Students may still purchase milk, or an extra milk for \$.50 each

**7) Are adult meals or 2nd meals free?**

No. The free program is only for currently enrolled students and not adults or visitors. Students will receive ONE free breakfast and lunch per day. Second meals will be an additional cost.

**8) How long does this free meal program last?**

Davenport students can receive free meals until December 31, 2020, subject to Federal Funding availability. The District will notify families if the Free Meal Program is scheduled to end earlier than December 31, 2020. When the program concludes, all families pre-qualified for Free or Reduced meals will be charged accordingly.



**9) What time is breakfast served at buildings daily?**

**10) Will free meals be served on days when school is not in session?**

No. On days when school is not scheduled such as Holidays, Professional Development, Inservice, Thanksgiving, and Winter Break no meals will be served.

**11) Does participating in the free meal program cause financial harm to the District?**

No. The District will receive federal funding for all meals served regardless of a family's income level until December 31, 2020 (subject to available funding).

**12) What will happen to my student's lunch balances during this time?**

All student lunch balances will remain available for extra purchases during this time. When the free meal program ends December 31, 2020, any funds remaining may be used toward future meal purchases.
