JROTC COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

The Military Science (JROTC) program prepares students for leadership roles while making them aware of their rights, responsibilities and privileges as Americans. JROTC motivates young people to be better citizens. The program promotes graduation from high school, and provides instructional opportunities which benefit the student, community and nation.

Davenport Community School District provides students with both the ARMY Junior Reserve Officer Training Program (located at Central) and the MARINE CORPS Junior Reserve Officer Training Program (located at North).

- Students must take JROTC for a minimum of two consecutive terms but are encouraged to sign up for all four terms.
- Enrollment in these courses for two or more terms in one school year will fulfill physical education requirements.
- Students will be provided uniforms without cost to the student.
- Students are assigned responsible leadership positions within the cadet battalion and participate in competitions at the regional and national level.
- Students are instructed in scholarship application procedures.
