## DIRECTOR LETTER

We are excited about what 2022 will bring to our parks, programs, and our community! Last year the City of Davenport received funds as part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) with a focus on program administration, neighborhood reinvestment, youth & family support, library services, creating places, and infrastructure investments. The Parks and Recreation department received \$2.5 million of these funds. Staff enthusiastically set to plan how to best use these funds to invest in updated and new amenities in our public spaces. Keep an eye out for news about additions like accessible playgrounds, replacement of existing playgrounds, renovation of tennis courts to multi-sport courts, obstacle courses, and splash features in several Davenport Parks.

Over the last three years, and especially with the forthcoming ARPA funding, we as a department have focused on improving, updating, and upgrading our parks and facilities. Now, our focus will turn towards improving and expanding recreational program offerings. Staff will evaluate how we are delivering programs, where we are delivering programs, and who is participating. Our goal is to ensure we are meeting the community's needs and wants. You, as a member of our community, will play a big part in this evaluation! Invitations to participate in discussions, surveys, and other avenues for providing feedback and suggestions.

This new focus on recreation program offerings goes hand-in-hand with the department's goal of increased community outreach and engagement. In early 2021, a new position was developed to have a dedicated position that plays a more active and collaborative role in the community as well as other City departments. It is with this role, that you have a centralized person to voice your concerns, thoughts, suggestions and ideas to help us grow programs and improve park spaces.

# LEARN *to Skate*

The River's Edge Learn to Skate program offers a variety of classes for people of all ages seeking to learn a new sport. Our eight-week seasonal sessions run year-round. We offer beginner snowplow, basic skills, free skate, hockey, and adult classes at an affordable price. Group lessons take place on Monday mornings, Thursday evenings, or Saturday mornings. Students register to attend only one day each week but can register for both days if you'd wish to receive more instruction time. All of our instructors are Safe Sport certified and professionally accredited through Learn to Skate USA.

## Learn to Skate FAQs

### Q: My child has never skated before, what level should I sign him/her up for?

A: We start skaters off in Snowplow 1 & 2 if they're between 3-5 years old and Basic 1 if they're 6 or older. You may also refer to the next few pages of this document to see what skills will be worked on in each level to better determine class placement. We strongly recommend bringing your child to public skate at least once before registering them for class to see if they like being on the ice.

### Q: My child is interested in hockey and has completed One Goal, what level should I sign him/her up for?

A: In the Learn to Skate program, we focus heavily on strong skating skills. Depending on their age, we would recommend signing them up for snowplow 1 & 2 or Basic 1. From there, we never hesitate to advance skaters into higher levels during the session if they're ready. Hockey 1 comes after Basic 3.

### Q: What should my child wear to class?

A: Loose warm clothing that allow for easy movement. Gloves, long socks, and helmet are preferred. For skaters in Hockey 1 & 2, helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads are recommended; for Hockey 3 & 4 and Advanced Hockey, full gear is required.

### Q: What is the makeup policy if my skater needs to miss a class?

A: Please let the LTS Coordinator know if you skater plans to miss class and the date you plan to make-up.

### Q: Do I need to purchase my own skates?

Skate rental is included in the program cost so you will not need to purchase your own. If you would like to purchase your own an instructor can help point you in the right direction.

### Q: Where can I sign up for skating classes?

A: Register in person at The River's Edge, by calling at 563-328-PARK (7275), or online at [recpro.davenportiowa.com](http://recpro.davenportiowa.com).

## LEARN TO SKATE DESCRIPTIONS

### Snowplow Sam Level 1 & 2

This class is designed for 3-5 year old beginners with little to no experience. Our instructors work off and on ice to develop introductory skating skills. The class is focused on fun, comfort, and movement with games and toys. This class is conducted without parents on the ice.

Focus: edges, glides, proper hockey stance, hockey stroking, stopping, and other basic hockey skills.

Prerequisite: Basic 3.

Ages: 6+

### Hockey 2

The primary focus of this course is establishing strong foundational Hockey skating skills, therefore, a hockey stick is not necessary. Helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads are recommended.

Focus: advanced glides, backward skating, advanced stopping, and other basic hockey skills.

Prerequisite: Hockey 1.

Ages: 6+

Fees: \$80 resident / \$100 non-resident

### Hockey 3

This class is for skaters that have passed Hockey 2 and would like to begin working on their hockey skills.

Focus: crossovers, forward/backward edges, one foot stopping, and other hockey skills. Full gear is required.

Prerequisite: Hockey 2.

### Hockey 4

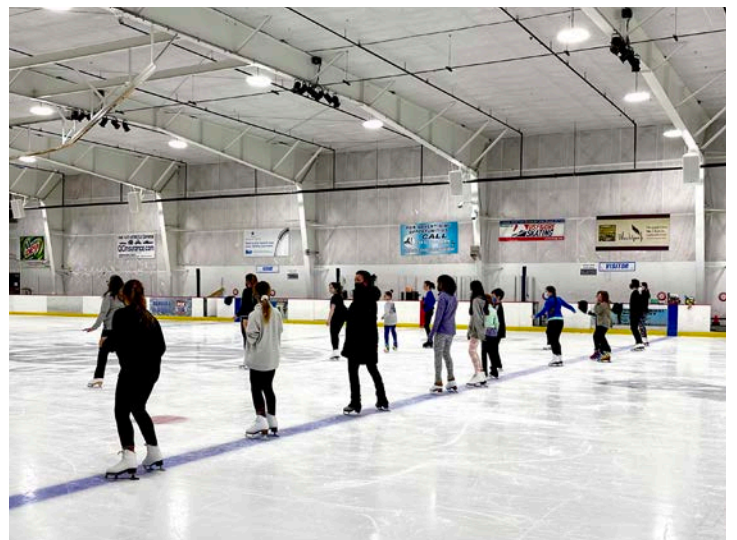
This class is for skaters that have passed Hockey 3 and would like to continue working on their hockey skills.

# LEARN *to Swim*

Davenport Parks and Recreation offers American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim Classes. For every level of Learn-to-Swim, our instructors follow a plan to introduce new swimming and water safety skills and build on previously learned skills. Each class is loaded with fun, engaging and challenging activities that motivate children to want to perform and learn to swim.

## Learn to Swim FAQs

### Q: Do you have any baby swimming lessons?

A: Currently we offer parent and child lessons beginning at age 6 months.

### Q: Am I allowed to get in the water with my child during lessons?

A: We ask that parents sit at the picnic tables\* so their child has the opportunity to focus on their instructor and class once they are in pre-level and above classes. (\*exception is Parent and Child lessons)

### Q: How do I know what level to sign my child up for?

A: Please review the Swim Stages chart for each level. We will determine if they need to be moved up or down a level during our initial assessment.

### Q: We took lessons last year, what level do I sign up for this year?

A: If you haven't been in a pool since last summer it may be a good idea to start them at the same level they left off. However, if you have been keeping up with swimming even a little bit, feel free to move them up to the next level. If we determine they need to be moved up or down a level during our initial assessment, we will do so and let you know why we made that decision.

### Q: What happens if my child doesn't pass?

A: Our goal is to ensure your child is learning all the skills they need to succeed in swimming for their safety. We give students multiple attempts to pass each skill before determining they are unable to pass. If your child does not pass the exit assessment we will advise you as to why they did not pass. We will let you know why we made that decision and recommend they retake the current level.

### Q: What happens if there is bad weather?

A: Sign-up for cancellation notification via Alert Iowa at [davenportiowa.com/alertiowa](http://davenportiowa.com/alertiowa). Each pool will be assessed to determine how the weather will influence the status of lessons. If lessons are canceled they will be made up on Friday of the same week. If you are not contacted regarding cancellations, then lessons are still on as scheduled.

### Q: What happens if we are going to be absent?

A: Please be aware there are no make-up days if your child is absent.

### Q: What should I pack for my child's lessons?

A: We recommend your child come ready to swim in their swimsuit. However, if you choose we do have locker rooms on site. We also recommend you bring a towel and sunscreen. You may bring an after lesson snack and drink (concessions are not open during lessons).

### Q: My child is older, do you have any teen or adult lessons?

A: Yes we do! Our teen lessons start at beginners who don't know how to swim at all and may even be a little fearful of water. Or intermediate lessons are for those who are looking to learn the strokes and lifelong fitness.

## LEARN TO SWIM DESCRIPTIONS

### NEW! Parent & Child Aquatics

Parent and Child Aquatics familiarizes young children to the water and prepares them to learn to swim in the American Red Cross Preschool Aquatics or Learn-To-Swim courses. It is not designed to teach children to become good swimmers or to survive in the water on their own. Parent and Child Aquatics give parents safety information and teaches techniques to help orient their children to the water. It also provides direction regarding how to supervise water activities in a responsible manner. These courses are a bonding experience that will fill parents and children with wonderful lifelong memories. In both level one and two, a parent must be present for each child enrolled to maintain a one-on-one parent to child ratio. In a lower enrolled class, if two parents want to participate with one child that can be allowed on a case-by-case basis. *Registration is required for the child only.*

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Parent & Child Level 1

This level introduces basic skills to parents and children. Parents are taught to safely work with their child in the water, including how to appropriately support and hold their child in the water and how to prepare and encourage their child to participate fully and the try the skills. Children are introduced to basic skills that lay a foundation to help them learn to swim. Several water safety topics are also introduced that are directed to parents.

Ages: 6-18 months

#### Parent & Child Level 2

This level introduces basic skills to parents and children. Parents are taught to safely work with their child in the water, including how to appropriately support and hold their child in the water and how to prepare and encourage their child to participate fully and the try the skills. Children are introduced to basic skills that lay a foundation to help them learn to swim. Several water safety topics are also introduced that are directed to parents.

Ages: 18 months-3 years

#### Pre-level 1

To help children feel comfortable in and around the water; to help develop good attitudes and safe practices around the water.

Ages: 3-6

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Pre-level 2

To begin locomotion skills and explore simultaneous and alternating arm and leg actions on front and back. Pre-requisite: Must have a Pre-level 1 certificate or be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements of Pre-level 1.

Ages: 3-5

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Pre-level 3

To learn to effectively coordinate combined simultaneous arm and leg actions and alternating arm and leg actions. Pre-requisite: Must have a Pre-level 2 certificate or be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements of Pre-level 2.

Ages: 3-5

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Level 1

To learn basic personal water safety information and skills, to help students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely. Pre-requisite: None.

Ages: 6-14

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Level 2

To give participants success with fundamental skills. Pre-requisite: Must have a Level 1 certificate or be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements of Level 1.

Ages: 6-14

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Level 3

To learn survival float, elementary backstroke, coordinate front crawl; introduced to scissors and dolphin kick; build on fundamentals of treading water; begin headfirst entries (diving). Pre-requisite: Must have a Level 2 certificate or be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements of Level 2.

Ages: 6-14

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Level 4

To develop confidence in strokes; learn sidestroke and butterfly, back crawl and breaststroke; turns are introduced. Pre-requisite: Must have a Level 3 certificate or be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements of Level 3.

Ages: 6-14

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Level 5

To refine the student's front crawl, back crawl, butterfly, breaststroke, and elementary backstroke and sidestroke; flip turns are introduced. Pre-requisite: Must have a Level 4 certificate or be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements of Level 4.

Ages: 6-14

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

#### Level 6

To refine strokes so students swim them with more ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances. To teach students how to prevent aquatic emergencies in open water environments and to introduce and practice self-rescue techniques. Pre-requisite: Must have a Level 5 certificate or be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements of Level 5.

Ages: 6-14

#### Teen Beginner

Teen Beginner is for swimmers who have never had a lesson or are not comfortable in deep water. Students will be taught the following skills: rhythmic breathing, crawl stroke, back crawl, and elementary back.

#### Teen Intermediate

Teen Intermediate is for swimmers who have the equivalent skills of a Level 2. Students will swim laps while learning side stroke sculling, front dive, and perfecting the front crawl, back crawl, and elementary backstroke.

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident

### Adult Beginner

Adult Beginner is for swimmers who have never had a lesson or are not comfortable in deep water. Students will be taught the following skills: rhythmic breathing, crawl stroke, back crawl, and elementary back.

### Adult Intermediate

Adult Intermediate is for swimmers who have the equivalent skills of a Level 2. Students will swim laps while learning side stroke sculling, front dive, and perfecting the front crawl, back crawl, and elementary backstroke.

Fees: \$30 resident / \$38 non-resident



### Junior Lifeguard

Are you between the ages of 11 and 14? Are you interested in lifeguarding? Then Junior Lifeguarding is for you! This program is designed to provide a foundation of knowledge, attitudes, and skills for future lifeguards. This foundation consists of five key areas: prevention of drowning and diving accidents, physical fitness, emergency response, leadership, and professionalism.

\*\*The Junior Lifeguarding course does not certify participants in first aid, CPR or AED or as a lifeguard.\*\* Pre-requisites: Must demonstrate the ability to swim the front crawl for 25 yards, tread water for 1 minute, and swim 10 feet underwater.

Ages: 11-14

Fees: \$56 resident / \$70 non-resident

### Adult Water Aerobics

Enjoy exercising using water routines choreographed to music! Great cardiovascular workout including an endurance and flexibility portion intended to strengthen and tone muscles. This class is designed to increase strength, flexibility, and joint mobility for those with arthritis or similar problems.

#### Ballet

Leotard, tights (suggested color: pink), dance skirt/shorts OR form fitting top, dance pants/leggings, tights. Shoes: pink or black leather/canvas ballet shoes. No house shoes or fabric soles.

#### Jazz

Leotard and/or form fitting top, dance pants/leggings, tights (suggested color: tan). Shoes: black/tan leather jazz shoes.

#### Tap

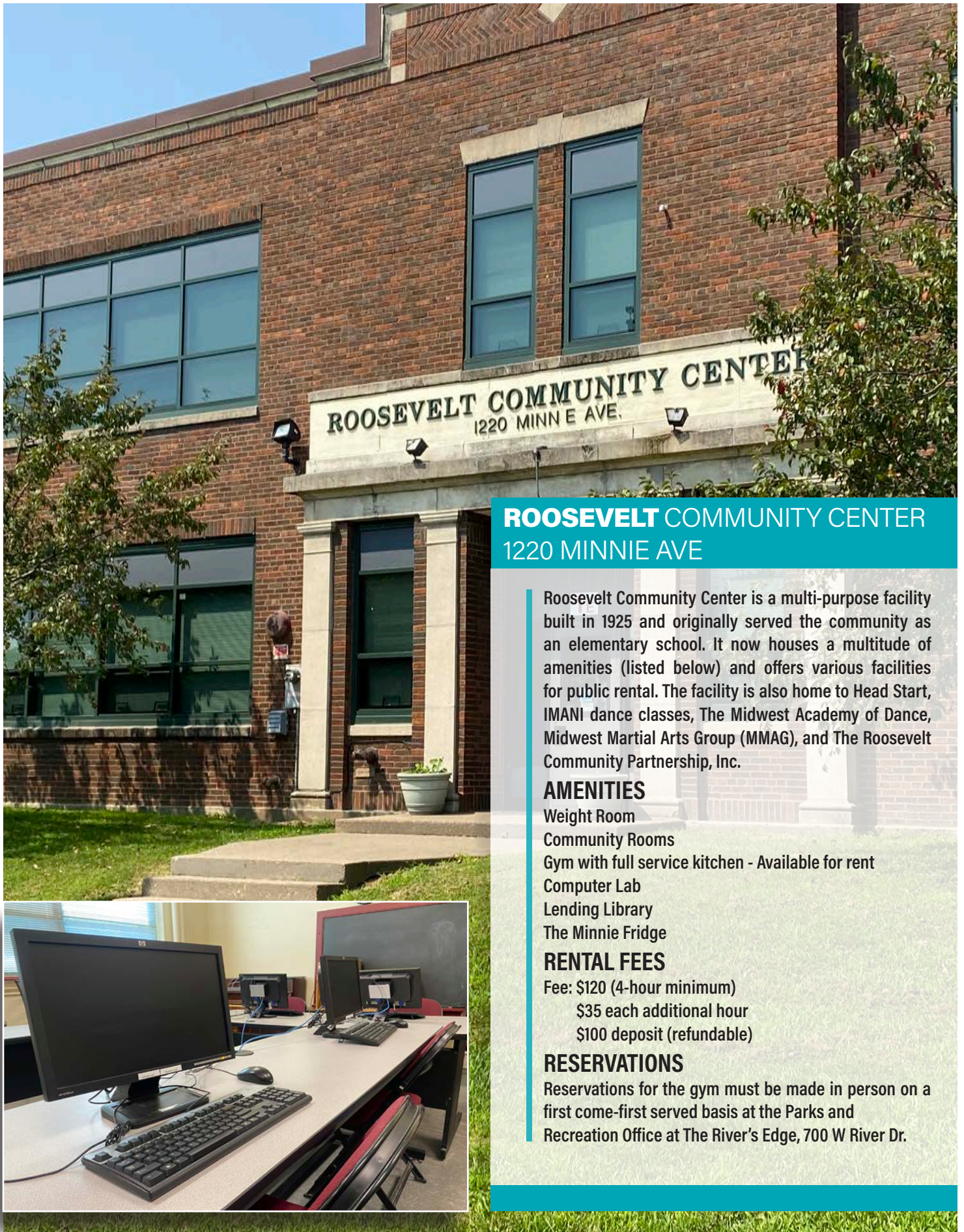

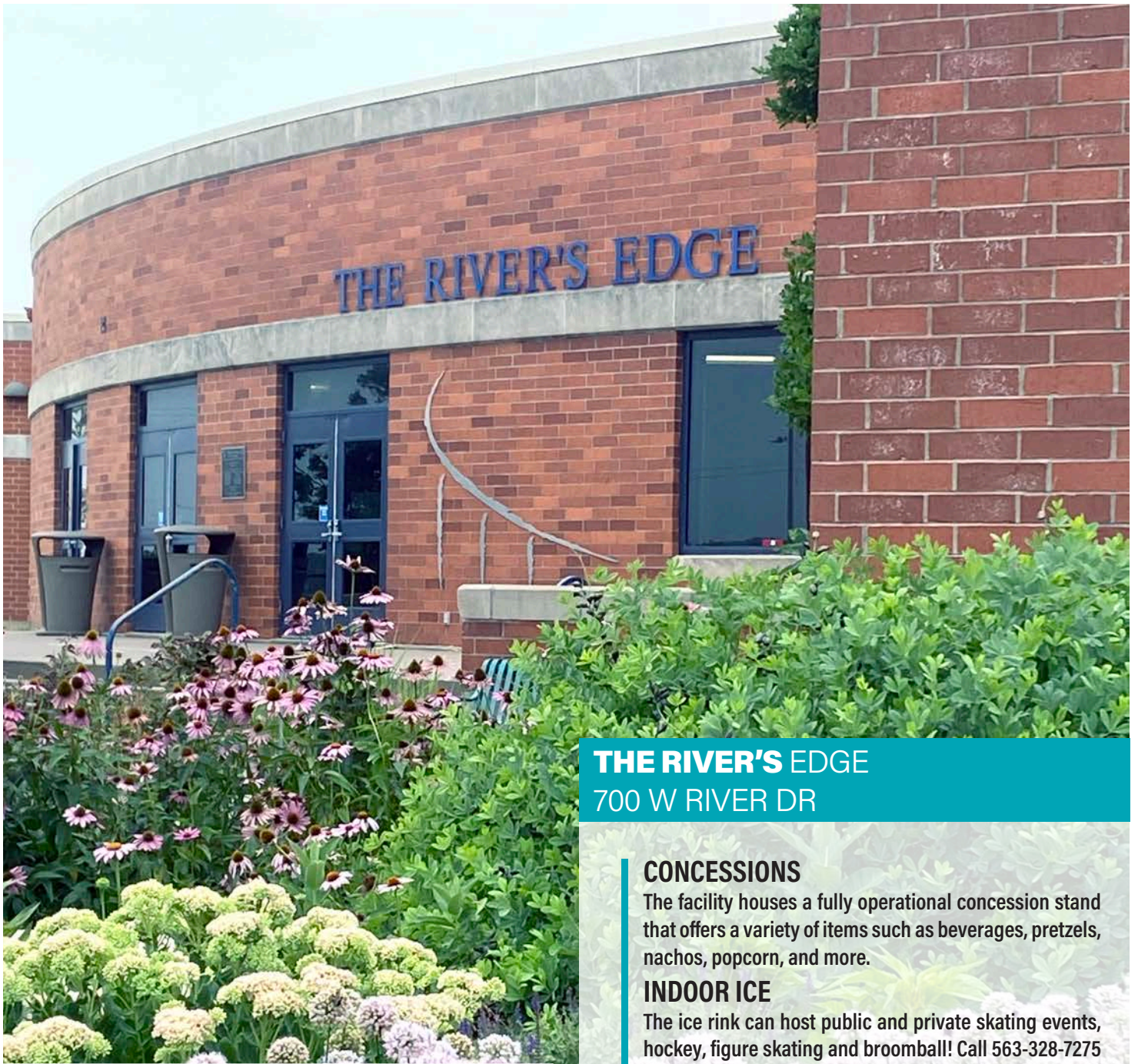
