Setting up for Zoom

In order to get the best audio and video for your Zoom lesson, please try to use these guidelines.

Light

Make sure that the light is directed toward the student. The student could be facing a window or lamp, or to the side of it. But the light shouldn't be behind the student - this causes too many shadows.


Light sources should be behind the device with the camera as much as possible.

Sound

Try to keep the room as quiet as possible. Any sound such as other devices or family members in the background distorts the connection and makes the lesson more difficult.

Teacher and student should experiment with placement of their devices to get the best audio that they can. Light source Camera, mic, and teacher

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Piano students

Because the piano teachers need to see the hands and face of their students, as well as the keyboard, try to angle the camera so that this is the view that the teacher has.
