Fryxell Geology Museum at Augustana College

It has one of the largest and finest collections of rocks, minerals, and fossils in the Midwest . Highlights include a wall of glowing fluorescent rocks, a cast of a Tyrannosaurus Rex skull, and a complete 22-foot long skeleton of Cryolophosaurus- a large crested dinosaur discovered in Antarctica.
