

Unsafe School Choice Option - Notification

Any student who becomes a victim of a violence, and a criminal charge has been filed, shall, to the extent feasible, be permitted to transfer to another school within the school district. For purposes of this rule, a victim of violence is a student who is physically injured, sexually assaulted or threatened with physical injury as a result of the commission of a crime (as defined by Iowa law) against the student while the student is in the school building or on the grounds of the attendance center. Within ten calendar days following the date of the request, the school district will offer an opportunity to transfer to the parent of the student. For purposes of this notice, a violent criminal offense is a forcible felony, physical assault other than simple assault, sexual assault, or extortion. This notice is sent to you under Iowa's Unsafe School Choice Option rules, 281 – Iowa Administrative Code 11.4.
