

NOW IS A GREAT TIME TO COMPLETE ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR NEXT YEAR!

Now is the perfect time to complete Online Registration for next school year. <u>Please note this does not format well on a phone or tablet</u>. The good news is that you can use your student's chromebook! Just remember to log in as CAMPUS PARENT, not student. DO NOT REGISTER AS A NEW FAMILY. Existing families who register as new will have to redo the application through Parent Portal.

- 1. Go to www.davenportschools.org
- 2. Click Parent Portal under the photo.
- 3. Click "click here to open Parent Portal via Infinite Campus."
- 4. Log in.
- 5. From the left hand menu, click More.
- 6. Select Registration.

Please email rosekr@davenportschools.org if:

- 1. you do not have a Parent Portal account or forgot your username.
- 2. you forgot your password and have already tried the Forgot Password link on the login page.
- 3. you do not see all of your students available for registration. Remember, only a parent/guardian in the primary household can register a student. Once you submit your application you cannot go back to add students.

You will register all students in one application. If you have new students, add them under the Student tab by clicking the blue New Student button.

DCSD Free Meal Sites for Children 1-18 Years

Children do not need to be present for parents to pick up the meals for children. Children able to walk or bike to sites can pick up food without an adult present. Families can go to ANY of the sites. Monday-Friday, 11 a.m.-1 p.m. in the parking lot of the following locations:

- Buffalo Elementary, 1000 Jefferson Street, Buffalo
- Smart Intermediate, 1934 W. 5th Street, Davenport
- Sudlow Intermediate, 1414 E. Locust Street, Davenport
- Williams Intermediate, 3040 N Division Street, Davenport
- Wood Intermediate, 5701 N Division Street, Davenport
- JB Young/ASC, 1702 N Main Street, Davenport

Children receive lunch and also breakfast for the following morning. Families who are on the Food Bank's "Friday Backpack Food Program" may pick up their food bags at the appropriate site on Fridays. Learning packets are also available to pick up for students without internet access.

Short Term Rental Assistance

This is a federally funded grant program that has income and property eligibility requirements. Those who are eligible and approved will not have to pay back any money they receive. Internet

Mediacom is offering low-cost (approx. \$10/month) internet for families to aid in distance-learning. 1-855-904-2225 Children must qualify for free or reduced lunches to get this offer, and must not be a current Mediacom internet customer/have not subscribed in the past 90 days.

Davenport Public Library's Eastern Avenue Branch and Fairmount Branch have wi-fi internet that extends into their parking lot, available for the public needing internet access.

DCSD buildings that currently have wi-fi that reach outdoor parking areas include; Blue Grass (by 6E doors); Buchanan (first few visitor spots); Hayes (north side of building near 8W doors); Mid-City (first few parking rows near main entrance); Sudlow (north side of building; Wood (near 15N door) Fillmore Elementary (near 3-S)
